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### Overview

Due to the severe weather emergency resulting from Winter Storm Jonas (Jonas), Mayor Bowser has authorized a District government closure for non-essential/non-emergency employees in subordinate agencies on Saturday, January 23 and Sunday, January 24, 2016.

### Declared Emergency – Closure Policy

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A closure (shut-down) declared by the Mayor allows non-essential/non-emergency employees to be dismissed from work.
