

**ELECTRONIC-DISTRICT PERSONNEL MANUAL

The attached pages replace the rules in Part I of Chapter 8 of the *Electronic-District Personnel Manual (E-DPM)*, Career Service. These rules are being replaced because of final rulemaking published in the *D.C. Register (DCR)* on March 14, 2014 (61 DCR 002122). The main purpose of these rules is to amend section 825 of this chapter to implement the provisions of D.C. Law 19-162, the “Foster Care Youth Employment Amendment Act of 2012” (Act), effective May 25, 2012. The main purpose of the Act is to add provisions to allow for a 10-point hiring preference to be awarded to an applicant for a Career Service position who is 18 to 21 years of age who is in foster care or who is within 5 years of leaving foster care. In addition, section 899, *Definitions*, is being amended to add definitions for the terms “foster care,” “foster child” and “ward of the state.” For the convenience of *E-DPM* readers, the entire chapter is being provided in this transmittal.
