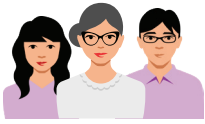

Family history

Take a brief survey about your personal or family history to find out if you will need further telephone consultation with a certified genetic counselor.



Genetic counseling and education

If your survey results suggest an increased risk, you can schedule a phone appointment with a genetics expert. They're available during the day, evening and weekend. This consult takes you on a deep dive of your personal and family history, addresses your health concerns and explores your options.

If your survey results say you're at average risk, you can still access online education and proactive genetic test options.



Genetic testing

If genetic testing is right for you, you'll get a kit with prepaid postage for saliva sample collection. Just collect your saliva sample and drop it in the mail. If you had a consultation by phone, your counselor will talk to you about your results and what they mean for you and your family.



Medical recommendations

When you have genetic counseling over the phone, you'll get a summary of your risk assessment. You'll also get genetic test results, if applicable, and guidance on medical options based on your risks. If you didn't talk to a genetic counselor but chose proactive genetic testing, you will get a summary from the lab. In any case, you can share these reports with any health care providers you choose.
