

**DISTRICT PERSONNEL MANUAL

With the October 3, 1980 publication in the *D.C. Register* (DCR) (27 DCR 4342) of the Notice of Final Rulemaking attached, the rules for Chapter 2, *Appointment, Retention of Personnel Rights and Benefits*, of Title 6 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (DCMR) – Government Personnel, were adopted.

This District Personnel Manual (DPM) Transmittal adds the aforementioned rules to Part I of Chapter 2 of the DPM. The statutory authority for the rules is section 204 of the District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978 (CMPA), effective March 3, 1979 (D.C. Law 2-139; D.C. Official Code § 1-602.04). Section 204 of the CMPA provides that persons employed by the District government serving on the date Title II of the CMPA, *Coverage: Status of Present Employees; Retention of Existing Personnel Rights and Benefits* (D.C. Official Code §§ 1-602.01 through 1-602.06), became effective, shall be guaranteed rights and benefits at least equal to those applicable to such persons immediately prior to the effective date of the chapter.


