Overview

Due to the severe conditions resulting from Winter Storm Jonas (Jonas), Mayor Bowser has authorized a District government closure for non-essential/non-emergency employees in subordinate agencies on Monday, January 25, 2016.

Declared Emergency – Closure Policy

A closure (shut-down) declared by the Mayor allows non-essential/non-emergency employees to be dismissed from work.
