**i** **NOTE:** This DPM instruction rescinds DPM Instruction No. 12-52, Excused Absence for Parents to Accompany Their Children to School at the Beginning of a School Year, dated August 15, 2014.

### Overview

This DPM instruction is being issued to clarify the appropriate type of communication that is necessary for an issuance relating to this matter.

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### Purpose

As mentioned above, District Personnel Manual Instruction No. 12-52, Excused Absence for Parents to Accompany Their Children to School at the Beginning of a School Year, dated August 15, 2014, is rescinded. Subsequent issuances on this matter will be prepared in the form of a DPM bulletin.

### Responsibilities

Department and agency heads or their designees have the responsibility to ensure that agency employees are informed of the provisions in this E-DPM instruction.

## Authority

1. Statutory Authority: D.C. Official Code § 1-612.01; and
2. Regulatory Authority: Section 1266 - Administrative Leave, of Chapter 12 of the D.C. personnel regulations, Hours of Work, Legal Holidays and Leave.

## Applicability


The provisions of this DPM instruction apply to each District government employee who is employed by an agency under the personnel authority of the Mayor.

## Collective Bargaining Agreement

In the event of a conflict between any of the provisions of this DPM instruction and any collective bargaining agreement (CBA), the provisions of the CBA shall control to the extent there is a difference.
