DISTRICT PERSONNEL MANUAL TRANSMITTAL SHEET NUMBER 166

The attached pages replace the rules in Part I of Chapter 36 of the District Personnel Manual (DPM), Legal Service. The rules are being replaced because of final rulemaking published by the Office of the Attorney General for the District of Columbia (OAG) in the D.C. Register (DCR) on December 21, 2007 (54 DCR 12269). The rules establish new rating categories and criteria for Legal Service line attorneys. Specifically, the rules abolish the existing four (4) rating categories of "Substantially Exceeds Expectations," "Meets Expectations," "Needs Improvement," and "Fails Expectations," and replaces them with these five (5) new rating categories: "Outstanding," "Excellent," "Satisfactory," "Marginal," and "Unsatisfactory." Additionally, the rules abolish the evaluation panels for the review by managers of draft evaluations of line attorneys before the draft evaluations are reviewed and approved by the Attorney General. Section 3617 of the chapter, Attorney Certificate of Good Standing Filing Requirement, was unaffected by the publication of this final rulemaking by the OAG. The entire chapter is being provided in this transmittal for the convenience of DPM readers.
