

**DISTRICT PERSONNEL MANUAL

With the July 16, 2004 publication in the *D.C. Register* (DCR) (51 DCR 7033) of the Notice of Final Rulemaking attached, a new Chapter 37, *Appointment, Reappointment, Discipline and Removal of Administrative Law Judges by the Commission on Selection and Tenure of Administrative Law Judges*, was added to Title 6 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (DCMR) – Government Personnel. The Office of the Deputy Mayor for Public Safety and Justice (ODMPSJ) was delegated rulemaking authority to adopt these rules via Mayor’s Order 2003-53, dated May 3, 2003. Subsequent Mayor’s Order 2004-98, dated June 9, 2004, delegated rulemaking authority for this chapter to the City Administrator (the ODMPSJ no longer exists).


This District Personnel Manual (DPM) Transmittal adds the aforementioned rulemaking notice to Part I of Chapter 37 of the DPM. The rules prescribe standards and procedures for the operations of the Commission on the Selection and Tenure of Administrative Law Judges pertaining to the appointment, reappointment, discipline, removal, and qualifications of Administrative Law Judges in the Office of Administrative Hearings, established by the Office of Administrative Hearing Establishment Act of 2001, effective March 6, 2002 (D.C. Law 14-76; D.C. Official Code § 2-1831.11(a)).
