


**DISTRICT PERSONNEL MANUAL

The attached pages replace the rules in Chapter 9, Excepted Service, of Title 6 of Subtitle B of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (contained in Chapter 9 of the Electronic-District Personnel Manual)). These rules are being replaced because final rules were adopted and published in the D.C. Register (DCR) on November 13, 2015 (62 DCR 014869). The rules that have been adopted (1) amend § 902, Excepted Service Qualifications and Other Appointment Requirements, to require that all persons appointed to the Excepted Service be subject to a credit check and criminal background check; (2) amend § 911, Pre-Employment Travel, Relocation, and Temporary Housing Allowance, to limit the amount of pre-employment travel expenses, relocation expenses, and temporary housing allowance that can be provided to an Excepted Service employee in accordance with the section; and (3) add a new § 921, Appointment to Inspector, Commander and Assistant Chief of Police in the Excepted Service, to the chapter. Amendments were also made to §§ 905, 908, and 999. Readers are also being informed that the provisions in § 915, Certificate of Good Standing Filing Requirement, of this transmittal require Council approval prior to amendments being made. As a result, no changes were not made to the § 915 provisions by way of the November 13, 2015 notice. For the convenience of E-DPM readers, the entire chapter is being provided in this transmittal.
